School classes (students and teachers) will have to present activities already done for reduction of energy consumption in their class.

#### **HOW TO DO IT:**

Write a short report (we would love to also receive Videos in addition to the report) with the improvement activities you have performed to achieve energy reduction. Present how you come up with the need (preferably based on the BMS data observed), what did you do and how you assess the outcome (if possible with BMS data).





#### CONTEST 2: Share your GAIA ideas!



#### WHAT YOU HAVE TO DO:

School classes (students and teachers) will present their ideas of how they will use and exploit GAIA tools and experience, in the future.

#### **HOW TO DO IT:**

Write a report (preferable with a presentation (in power point) /or video) with your ideas of how GAIA tools (GAIA Challenge, GAIA BMS) and the GAIA lab kit can be effectively further used and exploited in your school in the near future (e.g. next school year)

### CONTEST 3: Build your GAIA challenge's portfolio!



### WHAT YOU HAVE TO DO:

You have to enrich your portfolio in GAIA Challenge.

HOW TO DO IT: Go to the GAIA challenge and use all of the

available functionalities of the game (upload instances, upload videos, reports and images during the action missions) aiming at enriching your portfolio.

## **Participation in Exhibitions**

The GAIA consortium participated in a series of large science and research exhibitions around Europe.

### **Athens Science Festival 2019**

The 6<sup>th</sup> Athens Science Festival was held in Technopolis, City of Athens, between April 3 and 7, 2019, and this year it focused on good practices in order to reduce our environmental footprint and to plan a future for global protection to go hand in hand with growth. The Athens Science Festival is the largest exhibition on science and technology applications in education in Greece, with over 30000 visitors.

### Patras IQ 2019

The GAIA team participated at the Patras Innovation Quest Technology Transfer Exhibition (PatrasIQ) held on April 12 -14, in Patras, Greece, with thousands of visitors.

### **Patras Science Festival 2019**

GAIA participated in the Patras Science Festival, presenting the project and the GAIA control panel to students from Patras and western Greece. The Patras Science Festival 2019 is organized by the Science Communication educational group and the Hellenic Open University, under the aegis of the Greek General Secretariat for Research and Technology. The event was attended by more than 6500 visitors this year.





### LearnTec 2019

LearnTec is the biggest digital learning fair in Germany with over 11.600 participants. This year the event included 341 exhibitors from 15 countries, with our partner OVOS having a booth showcasing its educational portfolio, including the GAIA Challenge.
